Dear Friends

Christmas is here again and all over the world people are excited about celebrating the festivities of the season. Indeed, we remember those who are struggling, due to natural disasters, political upheaval and other circumstances. Christ, the stone, came to set up a Kingdom where He reigns that is not a political kingdom (John 18:36). We thank God for Jesus who came in human flesh to reign in us and to give us hope and all the joys this season brings. We pray all our friends and supporters will have a blessed and happy Christmas. We thank you because what we have achieved this year could not have been possible without your support – prayerfully, practically and financially.



The end of this academic year will see 28 children sitting their primary leaving examinations. Thirteen of them are fortunate to have sponsors and will be assured of further schooling, either in secondary or tertiary institutions. Unfortunately, the rest who have no sponsors will be unable to continue with their education. It is for this reason that the Charity desperately needs to build a skills centre where these pupils can go and gain skills to enable them to get jobs and secure their futures.

Child sacrifice is very prevalent in Uganda, due to the practices of Witch Doctors. The safety of children at the school is of paramount importance. As a result, a brick wall has been built around Mother Janet School. However, for those children who need to travel to school, there is an urgent need for a vehicle to be used to transport them, as some of them daily walk a round trip of up to 12 miles.

We commend Andrew Mwesigwa and the team who have taken care of the Orphanage while Rev John and Margaret have been away having a break.



Unfortunately, there has been a drought again in some parts of Uganda, including the area where Mother Janet Orphanage is situated. Due to the return of the refugees in the northern part of the country, all the food imported is directed to the north. There is also a threat that the Rwandan borders might be closed which will stop the food supply that is coming into the south western part of Uganda where Mother Janet Orphanage is located.

Please pray for this situation because there are over 300 children in the orphanage to feed and the food prices have now soared, with much of the food only available on the black market.

APPEAL FOR A PLATE OF FOOD

Last year the ALLHIM charity received an amazing response to the appeal made for a plate of food at Christmas. Over 700 people, both orphans and the very poor in the village, were fed a nutritious Christmas meal – the only change to their regular diets they would have during the year.

This year again we appeal for contributions towards a plate of food to make the orphans' Christmas special. As last year, a plate of food will cost £3.50 and your donations would be hugely appreciated.

GIFTS TO CHILDREN

For those who would like to give a Christmas gift to the children at Mother Janet, the Charity advises sending money so that gifts can be bought in Uganda. In doing so, this is much more cost-effective than buying presents in the UK and paying international postage. In addition, sending parcels to Uganda does not guarantee their arrival.

It is suggested that gift donations range from £3.00 to £20.00 and this money would be used to purchase items the children need most.
