## MOTHER JANET UPDATE

---

In our previous newsletter, we mentioned the drought which left the children and adults in the orphanage in dire need of food.

- We want to thank you for your financial support which enabled them to purchase food which, at the time, was at very high prices. God sent the rains which meant it was then possible to plant food which can be harvested during February and March.



- The new kitchen is now complete and in use. The Inspector of Schools in the district

commended the build quality. We thank God for the donation given to build it.

- The construction of a borehole is in progress. This will provide clean water for the orphanage in all seasons. The Mother Janet community is very excited about the borehole and is eagerly awaiting its completion.
- Thirty six children who sat for their end of primary school national exams received their results at the beginning of February. All children passed with very good grades. We commend the teachers who worked tirelessly to help them achieve such good grades. Please pray for the biggest number of these children as they have no sponsors to enable them to go onto further secondary/vocational education.



After completing his studies in pastoral theology, Andrew Mwesigwa is back in Uganda working hard to help in the day-to-day running of the orphanage. Andrew now preaches in the churches around Masaka town whenever he is invited and he also ministers to the young married couples/families. Please pray for Andrew and his family and for God's direction and provision in ministry.

## ALLHIM MISSION TRIP AND EVANGELISM

---

This year's mission trip will take place between 27<sup>th</sup> March and 10<sup>th</sup> April. Nine people are going to Uganda and will be based at Mother Janet Orphanage. Some will be teaching, others building the new dormitory for the smaller children, others carrying out electric wiring, some preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ in schools, villages and towns, as well as doing the general work in the day-to-day care of the orphans.

A large youth gathering will be taking place on the 30<sup>th</sup> March where over 3000 young people from schools and colleges, their teachers and tutors, as well as government officials from the education department, are expected to attend.

## CHRISTMAS APPEAL 2009

---



Many thanks to you all for responding to this appeal. The children and adults in the orphanage had a special day at Christmas (including the very poor families who were invited for the meal). Over 700 were fed, children had presents and, during the delivering of the food to the poor families in the villages, one widow and 4 orphans were found sleeping with a collapsed wall on

their mud-built house. Some of the money from the Christmas appeal fund was used to build a strong brick wall on her house and she was very grateful for such a unexpected, generous Christmas present.

Thirteen bunk beds were donated during the appeal and this will improve the sleeping conditions for 26 children at the orphanage.
