# **MOTHER JANET UPDATE**

**T**hirty four children who sat their National Primary Leaving Exams passed with excellent grades. We thank you for the support you have given to these children – for their education, medication and nutrition – factors which contributed to their outstanding performances.

Four lightning conductors were recently installed at Mother Janet. This work was a requirement following a recent Government Inspection of the school as several schools in the local area had been hit by lightning resulting in some children at those schools being injured.

Children at the school are doing well, thanks to the support of their sponsors. The message continues to be the same – and you will have heard it before – but

## **ACTION FOR CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE**

The work of ACYP in the community continues to expand. Child-headed families are being supported and many children have been able to return to school. Seventy seven HIV children are not being supported, on a regular basis, and given nutritious food to supplement their medication, greatly improving their quality of life.

Poor families who have received a pig or goat are being helped along the road to self-sufficiency, giving many the ability to provide for their own basic needs through the sale of offspring.

Children who had returned to school and sat their National Primary Leaving Exams passed very well. At the start of this academic year, there were 67 children who were unable to start secondary school due to lack of funds to purchase educational materials. Sometimes, the lack of funds to purchase an exercise book and/or a pen or pencil will prevent them returning to school for the year. ALLHIM has provided the funds to enable these 67 children to continue their education, with the materials they need.

Two 13 year old girls were destined to be given in marriage as the families did not have the funding to purchase their school requirements. The charity has been able to halt this process, enabling both these girls to return to school and have the opportunity to fulfil their potential. We thank God for His guidance in this.




# **FUNDRAISING CONCERT**
